

## STAFF TRAVEL TO WORK SURVEY RESULTS

At the recent staff away day Community First staff were invited to take part in a consultation about how they travel to work

- 14 members of staff travel 5 miles or under to work
- 5 travel 5-10 miles
- 8 travel 11-20 miles
- 1 travels 34 miles

Total daily mileage =  $245 \times 2 = 490$

If we assume that on average CF staff work a 4 day week 46 weeks per year = 184 days work requiring travel

$490 \times 184 = 90,160$  miles travelled to and from work per year!

Current travel to work

- 11 staff walk to work always and 11 more walk to work regularly
- 2 regularly cycle
- 23 always or regularly travel by car
- 3 occasionally lift share but mainly when going to meetings

Attitude to lift sharing

- 18 would consider occasional lift sharing

In the event of government imposed restrictions on car use

- 18 would like to be able to work from home
- 20 would arrange lift shares
- 11 would walk or cycle

Barriers to changing travel to work behaviour are:

- Working hours don't match up 27
- Inconvenience of lift sharing 13
- Work at home policy needed 15
- Washing and drying facilities needed 5

Lift sharing

- 8 members of staff potentially interested in offering lifts
- 17 people might be able to benefit from this

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
