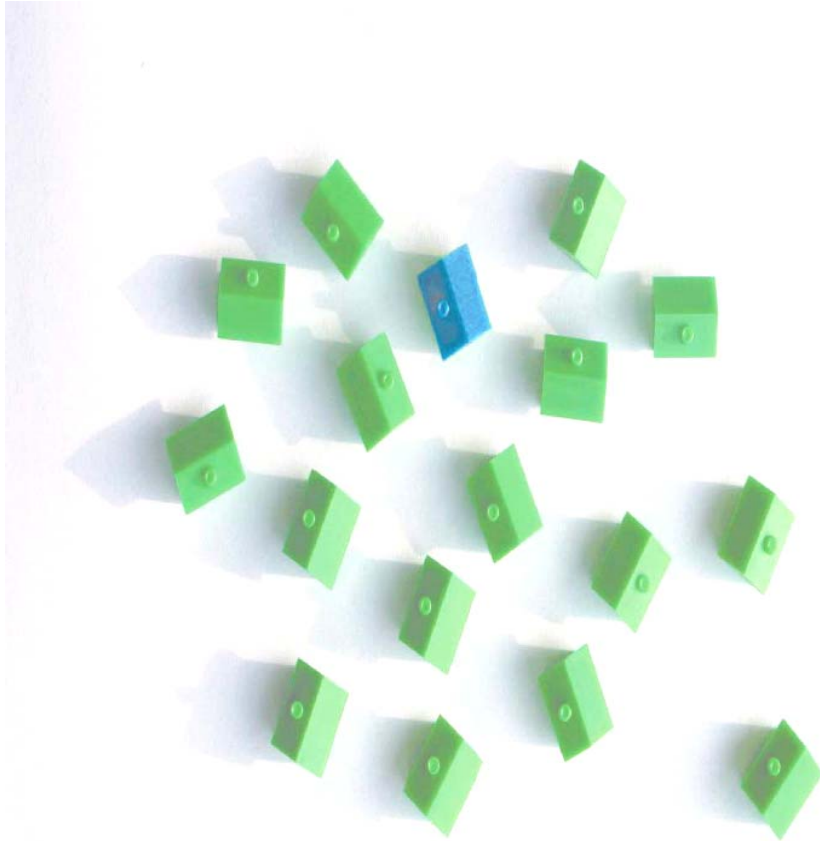


Rural Housing Enabler for Wiltshire & Swindon

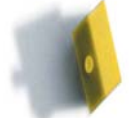
A rural housing enabler can help...

- Rural Communities wanting to retain their people and services
- People seeking affordable housing
- Landlords, both social and private
- Landowners interested in providing land for affordable housing




A rural housing enabler can

- Help villages assess their housing need
- Provide advice and information to villages on how to get more housing for their communities
- Work with communities and housing provider to develop affordable housing
- Act as honest broker between the parties involved
- Help to identify suitable sites for housing
- Work with housing providers to improve rural housing information and advice
- Influence local, regional and national housing strategies



We work with:

Wiltshire & Swindon Councils



Identify local housing need within their area and hold a housing register of need. They work with the Homes and Community Agency and Housing Associations to enable the provision of affordable homes.

Housing Associations

Work with the Councils and receive money from the Homes and Community Agency to provide affordable homes where they are most needed and manage the homes once they are built.

Community First

An independent charity which supports initiative in rural communities that directly benefit local people and which employs the Rural Housing Enabler.
